Welcome to the new school year! I hope everyone had a fun filled break.

It has been obvious over the last week that students and staff alike are off to a great start to the new school year. This is an exciting and busy time of year for most students as they learn to navigate new class and school routines, meet new friends and teachers, reconnect with old ones and settle back into focused learning.

Students that are starting school for the first time in reception and those that are new to our school have the biggest adjustment, but that said even moving to a new school year, working with a new teacher, increasing academic demands and a changing social circle can impact.

There are many things you can do to help your child settle back into school. Be prepared to get to know what is expected of you and your child, so that you don't tell your child one thing while the school says another. Take full advantage of information sessions where possible. If your child is new to our school encourage them to make some friends in the same class and to seek out a friendly face if feeling a little lost. Our students are always keen to help out in a time of need.

If your child's body clock is not yet ready for school after the relaxed pace of the holidays it is a good idea to focus on readjusting bed times and wake up times so that children are back to the rhythm of the school day as quickly as possible. If your child is leaving the house rushed, tired and grumpy at any point please take time out to let the class teacher know as this often leads to children getting anxious and irritable in class.

We have had 3 classes of new reception students start school as well as a number of new students in other year levels and of course new teachers.

The following teachers have started with us this year; Christina Savas appointed permanently as Reception teacher in the Sea Star Unit, Samantha Homan returning to a permanent appointment as Year 2

teacher in the Dolphin Unit, Kayley Karutz teaching Year 1 in the Dolphin Unit, Georgina Casbarra teaching Arts R-7, Michelle Angel teaching Arts R-2. Returning on contract are Jacqui Thomas - Year 5/6, Tania Schwenke - Year 4, Kylie Bath - Year 3, Gail Hall - Year 2/3 & Saras Vithi Rec/Year 1.

Helen Grant has been appointed as Deputy Principal for term 1 of this year and Rozika Pratap has been appointed to the position of Assistant Principal Well Being for the 2018 school year. Congratulations to both of them.

I am very excited about the positive, albeit very busy, start we have had to the 2018 school year and also the energy and willingness of students and in particular staff, to work towards continual improvement and innovation in practice.
